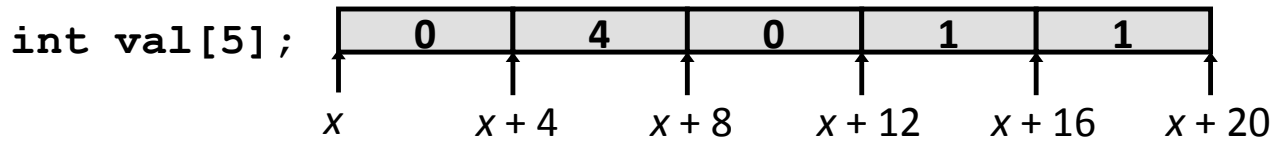


CSCI 2330 – Pointer Exercises

1. Consider the array shown below with the specified contents, starting at memory address x . For each of the expressions given below, indicate the **type** of the expression (**int** or **int***) as well as the **value** of the expression.



Expression	Type	Value
<code>val[4]</code>		
<code>val</code>		
<code>val + 1</code>		
<code>&val[2]</code>		
<code>*(val + 2)</code>		
<code>val + i</code>		

2. Implement the following C function without using the built-in `strlen` function.

```
int string_length(char str[]) {
```

```
}
```

3. Re-implement the above function, but do so *without* using array indexing.

```
int string_length(char* str) {
```

```
}
```
